The University of Vigo is an institution aware of the importance of humanities in the society's educational process, regarding our scientific-academic community and people who live in the environment. We have the firm conviction that humanistic knowledge is essential to know ourselves and to take based decisions; in short, to build a better world that is respectful of equality, diversity and environment.

This idea, with its singularities, is strengthened by the humanistic research carried out on the three campuses in a balanced way. On the Ourense campus, the research groups of the Faculty of History stand out for their studies on archaeology, territory, tangible and intangible heritage, and the relation to our universal history, of the Iberian Peninsula and of the peninsular northwest. On the Pontevedra campus, the research groups of the Faculty of Fine Arts host cutting-edge research on the latest trends that are developed through different scenic and visual tools and supports. On the Vigo campus a wide analytical range of lines and guidelines is presented in different modern languages, approached from philological, literary and cultural perspectives by the research groups of the Faculty of Philology and Translation.

In these three main areas mentioned, there are several coincidences:

Firstly, in the methodologies employed; far from stagnating in tradition, they evolve over time and together with the common sources/uses, they use new technologies that contribute to the improvement of the results and academic, national and international, dissemination in different contexts and supports.

Secondly, it stands out the eagerness to carry out transfer actions at different social and cultural levels and different age groups.

Thirdly, and related to the above, the firm intention to interact with the environment, which on many occasions becomes the object of study and with whom it is essential to share the results. In many of these actions, the work of the Office for the Transfer of Research Results (R&D Office) is essential to give an institutional form to relations with city councils, provincial councils and the Galician Regional Government. At another level, we must also mention the work of the Scientific Culture and Innovation Unit (UCC-i), which coordinates the dissemination activities of the university. And, of course, the intense and formidable work of our research staff in this field.

Finally, it should be noted that humanistic knowledge contributes to the improvement of society, and the relevant role of humanities in an increasingly technological world, which allows cultivating qualities such as creativity and critical thinking, but at the same time expanding the limits of its research in what is known as the digital humanities.




